As Advent begins, we hear the voice of St. John the Baptist calling us into the wilderness. Each year, the season of preparation starts with this stark yet hopeful command: "Prepare the way of the Lord."

Recently, I had the opportunity to spend time in one of the most renowned wildernesses in the world—the Serengeti. It was an incredible adventure, full of awe and wonder as we encountered lions, cheetahs, leopards, and countless other marvels of creation. Reflecting on this experience, I was struck by the connection between the words advent and adventure. At its root, Advent invites us into an adventure—a journey of preparation, discovery, and transformation.

The novelist George Eliot once wrote, "Adventure is not outside man; it is within." John's wilderness call isn't just about external preparation; it's an invitation to a deeper, inward journey. Advent challenges us to step into the wild terrain of our own hearts, clearing space for Christ to be born anew in us and in the world around us. What if we approached Advent not as a season of busyness or mere tradition, but as a holy adventure? A time to explore the untamed places within ourselves, to open our lives to God's transformative work, and to prepare a place for Christ's presence to dwell.

This Advent, may we each embrace the wild, sacred adventure of preparing the way of the Lord—in our hearts, our homes, and our world.

The season of Advent, which comes from the Latin word adventus meaning coming or visit, begins four Sundays before Christmas and ends on Christmas Eve. Advent is the beginning of the liturgical year for Christians.

During Advent, we prepare for, and anticipate, the coming of Christ. We remember the longing of Jews for a Messiah and our own longing for, and need of, forgiveness, salvation, and a new beginning. Even as we look back and celebrate the birth of Jesus in a humble stable in Bethlehem, we also look forward, anticipating the second coming of Christ as the fulfillment of all that was promised by his first coming.

The Christmas season begins at sundown on December 24 (Christmas Eve) and lasts until Epiphany of the Lord (January 6). This period is popularly referred to as the twelve days of Christmas.

United Ministries was formed 37 years ago by area congregations to prevent homelessness for families in crisis in Escambia and Santa Rosa counties. We provide rent, mortgage and utility assistance to families who are going through difficult times, offering hope, support, encouragement and empowerment as families come out of crisis and regain stability moving forward. There are so many families in our community who are living paycheck to paycheck, and are just one crisis away from losing their homes, or losing access to their water or power. United Ministries walks alongside these families as they are going through hard times - with compassion

and grace, we offer a listening ear to stressed out single moms; we encourage exhausted and overwhelmed single dads; we help find better work opportunities for couples or connect grandparents raising grandkids with social support to help along the way. We do whatever we can to help families heal and to offer them the hope and love of God!

Jane Smith, a recent client of ours reached out to us months after we were able to help her get caught up on rent - she had come out of an abusive relationship and was taking some really courageous steps to stabilize herself and her kids. The Network voted on our new topic for 2024 and it was decided to take on a new issue regarding affordable housing. While we will continue to monitor civil citations and the state of affordable rental housing in Pensacola and Escambia County, the Research Committee will decide on a new approach for affordable housing and work toward a new solution to present. Our goal for the Nehemiah Action is to have 225 FUMC members attend.
