Ushers & Greeters

Welcome church members and guests, distribute bulletins, assist with seating, and collect offering in worship services.

Communion Stewards & Servers

Communion Stewards prepare, set up, and clean up all communion elements for a service. Servers assist pastors with serving communion during worship.

Lay Readers

Serve during worship by reading varying texts and passages.

Light and extinguish candles, assist with offering and communion in worship.

Open to all adults. Sings at either the 8:30 or 11am Main Sanctuary worship service.

Flower Ministry

Deliver bouquets made from the flowers used during Sunday worship. These bouquets are delivered to the sick, homebound, or anyone in need of a brighter day.

Respite Ministry

Provides a fun, engaging environment for individuals living with dementia. Through creative arts, music, trivia, physical and intellectual fitness, and fellowship, Respite provides opportunities for social connection and fulfillment for participants while giving their caregivers much needed respite.
