WHAT IS JOYFUL, JOYFUL ABOUT?

Last April our church embarked on something called Project Grow. It was a response to a call and desire for growth in the church in which church leadership laid out a plan. 
JOYFUL, JOYFUL INFORMATION MEETING



MISSION SPOTLIGHT - KIDS FEEDING PROGRAM

KiDS FEEDING PROGRAM







The Kids Weekend Feeding Program is a mission of First United Methodist Church of Pensacola, and helps shop for, pack, & deliver food to local schools to meet the needs of hungrychildren at times when other resources are not available. They supply enough food to last them through the weekend until they return to school. This program began in October, 2007 at Allie Yniestra Elementary School with 58 children from 17 families. When the school year ended, we were feeding 73 children from 20 families.

We currently serve 292 children every week from Lipscomb Elementary, Ensley Elementary and Ferry Pass Elementary. Kids are identified by their teachers and school counselors throughout the year making this program flexible for itinerant/homeless families, or those in crisis. We are able to provide these meals for each student for \$2.53 per weekend or \$80.96 per year.

Grows churches and helps develop leaders in the Tanzania UMC.


