



THE GROWING SEASON: STEWARDSHIP

Today is the fifth Sunday of “The Growing Season.” The Growing Season is our discipleship campaign at First Church. It is our way of teaching, learning, and practicing the Great Commission of Jesus Christ. The Great Commission has five key components that we call ‘visions’. They are Christian Education, Christian Evangelism, Christian Worship, Christian Missions & Outreach, and Christian Stewardship. Each Sunday during The Growing Season we will feature a different vision along with a story told by the people that make up our congregation. Our prayer for this season is that we are reminded of the different ways in which we are called to serve Jesus Christ and that we are moved into being a more active part of the church’s ministry.

This week we are focusing on Christian Stewardship. In our worship of God, we learn that all that we have belongs to God and that God has called us to be ‘stewards’ or ‘managers’ of all that God has given to us. Christian stewardship is quite simply our response to God for all that God has given to us. To belong to our congregation is to be a steward. Today, each of us are getting a “Christian Stewardship” pamphlet and an “Estimate of Giving” card. Read over these materials carefully, take them home, and pray about how God is calling you to serve. We ask that you bring the Estimate of Giving cards back with you next week, on Consecration Sunday.

TODAY'S LECTIONARY SCRIPTURE

Proper 18

The First Reading—Jeremiah 18:1-11—the prophet puts forth an allegory for God's dealings with Jerusalem and Judah: it is like the hands of a potter working with clay.

The Psalter—Psalm 139:1-6, 13-18—With marvelous wisdom, God alone perceives the heights and depths of life.

The Second Reading—Philemon 1-21—the letter that Paul sent to Philemon asking that he receive back in love the runaway slave Onesimus, who was voluntarily returning to him.

The Gospel—Luke 14:25-33—Jesus speaks of the necessity of counting the full cost of discipleship.

Each of us is encouraged to read scripture during the week. If you don't already have a daily devotion, the scriptures below are designed to expand the range of biblical reading in worship and personal devotion. You can find them in the bulletin each week.
