PASTORAL LETTER

Dear Friends,

Greetings to you, in the name God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

I am writing this letter to inform of the status of our church. Last night, Tuesday May 25, 2021 we had the first in-person meeting of our Church Council since last year. We heard three reports and I shall share briefly what we learned.

Our first report was from the Finance Committee. We are grateful to Holly Houghton (chairperson) and the committee on Finance for their excellent work in a very difficult time. As you should expect, we ended last year with a deficit in our 2020 budget. Likewise, we currently have a deficit in 2021 revenues. Our pledge income remained high and constant throughout last year and this year. Because we did not have in-person worship, we predictably suffered the loss of 'loose-plate offerings', which for our congregation is a substantial part of our financial support. We were fortunate to obtain two PPP loans (an extension of the U.S. Small Business Administrations 'SBA Loans', which enable small businesses adversely impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic to obtain financing needed to continue their business operation). When these loans are officially forgiven, we will reduce our deficit for last year and for this year. We are grateful to God for this financial help, and we are thankful for the excellent work of the Reverend Ken Autrey (Executive Pastor) and Mrs. Liz Noyes (Director of Finance) for their diligent work in obtaining and administering these funds to keep our employees in their jobs and our church ministries operational.

I am happy to report that FUMC Pensacola has paid its share in the conference apportionments through May 2021. The mission of the Church is alive and well! Thanks be to God!

If you are actively involved in supporting of our church financially and you wish to discuss the details of our church's financial status, please contact [Mr. Autrey](#) and [Mrs. Noyes](#).

The second report was from Mr. Philip Bates and our Trustees. We are grateful to Mr. Bates and our Trustees for their care of our buildings. Not only did we suffer from the COVID pandemic, all eleven of our buildings sustained significant damage from hurricane Sally. At present, we are in litigation with our insurance provider (Frontline Insurance). We have hired a Public Adjustor and a major law firm; we fully expect the insurance company to cover some \$8-million dollars of our damages. As you may already know, we expect this extended process to be a long one. Therefore, I call on all our members and friends to be patient, full of hope, and strong resolve, and to pray. The church

belongs to God, and with God's sure help we will endure and achieve satisfaction in this litigious process. As the Apostle Paul would say, let us boldly pray and be full of courage.

Currently, the Noah's Ark building, some rooms in our educational complex and office building, the youth center, the gymnasium in the Henry Roberts center, and the Wesley Abbey are being used to the fullest extent possible. Please remember that in all of this, your safety is our primary concern. Unfortunately, our beautiful sanctuary is not, at present, operationally safe. Our trustees are effectively working with all of these issues. We shall keep you apprised of progress in these matters.

Our third report was the Pastor's Report. Throughout last year and currently, the ministries of our congregation have continued: the doors, for a time, were closed, but the ministries of our church remained open and operational. From April 2020, we have every week offered on-line Sunday worship, and provided some 260 week-day devotions ('A Word from Wesley'), on-line Sunday School classes, Bible studies, and meetings. I am happy to report that the response to these efforts has been immense. People from other countries (for example, Germany) and across the USA have contacted us in appreciation and support for our unflagging zeal in sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ. And, again, our church staff is to be commended for their diligent work.

We have thus far received 20 new members; welcomed 12 members as 50-year-Members; recognized and celebrated 16 persons as 2021 High-School-Seniors. Twenty-four of our members have died (16 in 2020; 8 in 2021).

We have continued to preside at weddings, officiate funerals, perform baptisms, provide counselling, visits in homes and hospitals, and to conduct the affairs of the church. Our Bishop and District Superintendent have repeatedly voiced their appreciation for FUMC, as have ministers and Christians in our conference, across the South-eastern Jurisdiction and our country.

On Monday May 24, the ministers of our conference met in Montgomery, Alabama, with our Bishop David Graves. He delivered a strong address and charge to our Church. He will be our Bishop and will also preside over the South Georgia Annual Conference of the UMC. Our AWF Conference staff has been reduced and there are now only four districts in the Alabama West Florida Conference. The superintendents will now oversee two districts, instead of one. This is, of course, a transitional adjustment, which will probably remain in effect until 2024.

I thank all of you for your love and support of our United Methodist Church.

Rejoice! The Church of Jesus Christ is alive and well and making disciples of Jesus Christ! Thanks be to God!

I look forward to seeing you in church on Trinity Sunday, May 30, 2021!

The Prayer Shawl Ministry at First United Methodist Church of Pensacola is a group of faithful women who love to knit, crochet, and more importantly, desire to encourage others during hard times. Prayer shawls are presented to anyone who needs assurance of God's love and comfort in their lives.

Pre-pandemic, this group met Tuesday mornings on the First Church campus for a morning of fellowship while creating their beautiful gifts to share with our community. During the pandemic they adapted to meet via Zoom to continue their ministry. Over the past year, the Prayer Shawl Ministry created over 1200 prayer shawls, prayer squares, and newborn baby blankets that have been shared with the following: those that are sick, healing or lost a loved one, residents and staff in healthcare communities, the homeless community, and our newest babies in the First Church family. These women served so many people, near and far, all while staying safe at home.

"It is a blessing for me to work with the Prayer Shawl Ministry. They have so much fun together as they use their gifts to create something so meaningful and comforting to others in need. I often have the special privilege of sharing their gifts with others. I love to report back to the Prayer Shawl Ministry the heartwarming stories I receive from the recipients of their beautiful creations. I also have friends in the community ask if the First Church Prayer Shawl Ministry can make special projects for their organization, and these amazing women are always up for the challenge.", stated Jennifer Piver, Director of 50 Forward and Pastoral Care Ministries.

Prayer shawls, prayer squares, and newborn baby blankets are the Prayer Shawl Ministry's normal projects, but they have been known to take on special projects to meet the needs of our community. They have been creating Fiddle Sleeves for Alzheimer's patients, caps and blankets for NICU babies, Purple Hearts for Veterans on Hospice, and bookmarks for multiple ministries.

All of the beautiful creations that the Prayer Shawl Ministry provides are special, but the prayer shawls and scarves they create for our Graduating Seniors is a very special tradition that began at First Church in 2013. Each year, our Youth Director, Denise Van Atta, shares a list of Graduating Seniors with our Prayer Shawl Ministry. At the Senior Breakfast in May, each student receives a prayer shawl that was selected especially for them and prayed over by the Prayer Shawl team and our staff.

Karen Bower, member of the Prayer Shawl Ministry sates, *"Being able to wrap a prayer shawl or scarf around a graduating senior makes us realize that they are going out into the world knowing that First Church is standing behind them."*
